Heritage Safari Lodge & Hemingway Luxury Tented Camp

The original hotel, built in 1948 on the main road from Durban to Lourenço Marques (Maputo), was purchased by the Zulu Nyala Group in 1996.

The hotel has been restored to its original colonial grandeur, complimented by delightful African ambience, with new accommodation facilities having been developed to underline Zululand's cultural village's development.

Conveniently located, in the heart of the LSDI (Lebombo Spatial Development Initiative), guests have easy access to many of the conservation, wildlife and cultural attractions in the region, including Hluhluwe / Umfolozi Game Reserve, the World Heritage Site - St Lucia, Sodwana Bay, Lake Jozini and the Tembe Elephant Park.

HERITAGE SAFARI LODGE

Situated adjacent to the Zulu Nyala Safari Game Reserve, only 200 meters away from the closest entrance gate, the Heritage Safari Lodge is ideally located for guests to enjoy all the activities on offer at Zulu Nyala Safari Game Lodge. Only 5 kilometers off the main N2 highway the Zulu Nyala Heritage Safari Lodge is easily accessible by both coach and motor vehicle. Visit our live cultural village and experience Zulu dancing, bead work, beer and basket making and stick fighting.

ACCOMMODATION

- All 57 en-suite guest rooms are fully air-conditioned with separate bath and shower. These spacious
 colonial style rooms are all equipped with tea / coffee making facilities, overhead fans, hairdryer, wall
 safe and direct dial telephones
- To add to the accommodation on offer are 37 Hemingway style en-suite safari tents. The tents have all
 got a private viewing deck, tea / coffee making facilities, hairdryer and direct dial telephones
- All rooms and tents are serviced once daily
- Check-in time from 14h00 (Early arrivals by prior arrangement).
- Check-out time by 10h00

ACTIVITIES

In addition to the abundant game (giraffe, zebra, blue-wildebeest, Nyala, and much more) the reserve also has elephants, black rhino, white rhino, buffalo, leopard, hippo and a wealth of bird life. Safari game drives are conducted in open 4 x 4 vehicles by qualified guides. Afternoon safari game drives continue after "sundowners" into the early evening. Game viewing by spotlight after dark offers the chance of seeing unusual nocturnal species. Rangers host individual groups of guests, ensuring that each guest's bush experience and special interest is attended to. Rangers' co-ordinate their guest's programme: conducting bush walks and other activities. A guest's limited time is well utilized and special interest groups are catered for.

GAME DRIVES

Summer : 06h00-08h30&16h30-18h30 Winter : 06h30-09h00&15h00-17h30

These are available both in the Zulu Nyala Safari Game Reserve and the Hluhluwe / Umfolozi Game reserve by our 4 x 4 Safari Game Drive Vehicles. Safari activities may be arranged to suit guest's individual requirements. Booking in advance is essential.

WALK AND TRACKING TRAILS

Trails can be adapted to suit the guest's needs, either by prior arrangement or arrangement with the guest's Ranger (not valid for Tour Operators). A maximum of 7 guests are taken on a walking trail at any given time.

ZULU NYALA CULTURAL VILLAGE

A self sustaining Live-In Zulu Village, situated in close proximity to the Zulu Nyala Heritage Safari Lodge bordering the Zulu Nyala Safari Game Reserve. A look at the lifestyles and traditions of the Zulu culture.

- Children under the age of 5 are not permitted on Game Drives.
